

Milton P & R and Impington Cycleway CTC Comments and Recommendations.

Comments are listed starting from Cycle/foot bridge over the A10 going west.

1. We consider that this will be a busy Commuter/Children's access to school route and therefore justifies a 3.0M width rather than the 2.5M on offer.
2. There are two proposed routes at the waste site. We understand the Council favours the straight on route and if so will have to give consideration to the potential dangers of left turning traffic. If the turn in and cross route is used then the route needs to be straightened out so cyclists approach the crossing at right angles thus getting a good view and can keep moving if the road is clear.
3. The provisions for the end of the route in Impington need further detailed consideration. Cyclists need to be able to return to the road safely possibly with a build out to protect them at this point.
