

## Trumpington to Hauxton Mill CTC Comments and Recommendations

This is an interim provision which was proposed by Cambs C.C. to enable cyclists to avoid the new Addenbrooke's Access Road Junction and the expected increase in traffic at the M11/A11 junction which is to be signalised in the near future. It also allows cyclists wishing to join the new Access Road to cross directly to it. Cyclists will be able to access the cycleway along the line of the Guided Bus Route and the existing cycle route into Trumpington. There may be further provisions at a later date allowing direct access around the back of the Park and Ride. When Trumpington Meadows is completed there will be an access route to Grantchester Road just west of the church. The cycle route will be re routed at this stage.

1. We consider that the provisions offered are reasonable. The path and new sections to be provided will be 3M wide.
2. We recommend that there should be some restriction where the path joins the A10 at Hauxton Mill to discourage cyclists from crossing the A10 at this point. Perhaps a barrier fence would be adequate just up to the bridge over the river.
3. It may be necessary to consider the provision for cyclists crossing Hauxton Road to the New Addenbrooke's Access Road
